so that hee saw no way
how hee could serve the
Lord publickly any longer
there for the diffusing of
his people: his meetings
being still Disturbed by
them: october: 31: 1652. hee
went to London: that hee
might inoy more liborly

for him self; and bee more
helpfull to the people of god
where hee Continued, During
the persecution: improving
the talent which god had
given him by preaching as
publickly as might bee there
among gods people two Days
after hee left his habitation
at Douer being nouemb: 22
1652 his persecutors Came
with a false warrant of three
